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SECTION 1

Executive Summary

CasaNova Relief is an emergency shelter procurement and delivery program operated by MegaCargo Canada (legal entity 1588 Exports Inc.), an international freight-forwarding company based in Quebec, Canada. We supply fully equipped, container-based shelter units to institutional buyers — NGOs, UN agencies, municipal and national governments, and diaspora relief organizations — and manage the complete chain from factory floor to community site under a single accountable contract.

This dossier is prepared for procurement teams. It sets out our company standing, product formats, reference pricing, delivery model, compliance documentation, and commercial terms, with annexes for technical specification, a procurement compliance checklist, and a request-for-quotation template.

CasaNova Relief is not sold to individual consumers. It is structured for institutional procurement, with the documentation, customs handling, and single-point accountability that formal buyers require.

SECTION 2

Who We Are — Company & Legal Standing

A logistics-backed shelter procurement program

A shelter unit is only useful once it arrives, clears customs, and is assembled on site. Because MegaCargo Canada controls sourcing, ocean freight, customs clearance, and last-mile delivery under one contract, buyers work with one accountable partner instead of coordinating a factory, a freight line, a broker, and an assembly crew separately.

MegaCargo Canada operates active accounts and credit workflows with major ocean carriers (including Maersk, MSC, CMA CGM, ZIM and Hapag-Lloyd) supporting international container movements. Air-cargo agent accreditation (IATA / CASS) is in progress; we do not represent it as held until formally issued.

SECTION 3

The Challenge We Solve

After a disaster or large-scale displacement, permanent reconstruction can take many months to several years, leaving displaced families in schools, gymnasiums and informal camps through the interim. Container-based shelters compress that timeline from years to weeks: they ship flat-pack or expandable,

deploy on compacted gravel pads without poured foundations, and can be assembled by small local crews in hours. The advantage over traditional construction is speed, transportability, controlled cost, and scalability from a single unit to a full community deployment.

All formats share one manufacturing standard, one logistics partner, and one point of contact. Units use a steel frame with insulated panels; the Family format includes private rooms, bathroom and kitchen rough-in, with an optional off-grid solar upgrade. Full specifications in Annex A.

SECTION 5

Reference Pricing

Reference price — CasaNova Relief Solo (20 ft container-house)

USD \$5,633 / unit

The reference price above is a per-unit starting point for the 20 ft container-house. Final pricing is confirmed by formal quotation and depends on order volume, destination port, Incoterm (FOB or CIF), specification options, and prevailing ocean-freight rates. Larger orders and community-scale deployments are quoted at improved unit economics. A request-for-quotation template is provided in Annex C.

SECTION 6

Seven-Step Delivery Model

1. Request & Quote	Free institutional quotation, typically within 24 hours.
2. Contract & Deposit	Contract signing and deposit to release production.
3. Factory Production	Manufacturing with periodic photo updates during the build.
4. Inspection	Pre-shipment inspection with video walkthrough and quality certification.
5. Ocean Freight	Sea freight managed end-to-end by MegaCargo Canada to the nearest port.
6. Customs Clearance	Port clearance, customs documentation, HS codes and import declarations.
7. Site Delivery & Assembly	Flatbed delivery and local assembly in hours, not months.

SECTION 7

Logistics Capabilities

MegaCargo Canada coordinates sourcing, production oversight, ocean freight, customs and final delivery across Latin America, the Caribbean, Africa, the Middle East, Asia Pacific and North America. Regional transit windows are confirmed per corridor at the quotation stage.

Illustrative Deployment Model

The following is an illustrative deployment model, not a claim about a specific completed project. In a rapid-response scenario, a relief organization confirms a required number of family units; CasaNova Relief issues a procurement-format quotation, releases production on contract, and manages consolidated ocean freight to the nearest port. On arrival, MegaCargo Canada clears customs and coordinates flatbed delivery and local assembly, bringing families from displacement into weatherproof shelter within weeks rather than months.

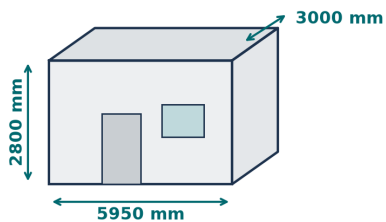
